## Description

H.M. Woggle-Bug, T.E. appears as a human-sized insect. "H.M." in his title stands for "highly magnified" (a reference to the fact that he is a giant, as woggle-bugs go); and "T.E." stands for "thoroughly educated" (a reference to his academic education, of which he is most proud). The Woggle-Bug is very intelligent and learned, but slightly pompous. He means well, but can sometimes grate on others' nerves. He always introduces himself by presenting a card inscribed with "MR. H.M. WOGGLE-BUG, T.E."
The Woggle-Bug has a particular fondness for puns, believing that they show culture, refinement, and command of the language. Unfortunately, some of the puns are in bad taste. Examples of puns uttered by the Woggle-Bug include:

1. Of the Saw Horse breaking a leg: "A horse is no use until he is broken."
2. Of the Woggle Bug riding on the Saw Horse: "Then he would be a horse-and-buggy."
3. Of Jack Pumpkinhead smashing his head: "Then he would no longer be a pumpkin, but squash."
